Subject: **Proposed technical amendments to Exhibit F and Exhibit G.**

The following technical amendments to Exhibit F and Exhibit G to Ordinance No. 2013-45s would correct various typographical errors and omissions in the Exhibits as described below.

1. On page 24 of 111, of Exhibit G, line 22, after “a.” insert “Category III wetlands less than 2,500 square feet in size which are not:” to show as follows:
 6. Category III and IV Wetlands. The mitigation requirements of PCC 18E.30.050, Wetland Mitigation, will not be imposed for activities within:
 - a. Category III wetlands less than 2,500 square feet in size which are not:
 - (1) Contiguous with a freshwater or estuarine system;
 - (2) Located within shoreline jurisdiction; or
 - (3) Part of a mosaic wetland complex, as set forth in PCC 18E.30.020 E.2.

2. On page 1 of 1, of Exhibit F, line 26, delete “Chapter 18E.40 PCC” and insert “Chapter 18S.30 PCC” to show as follows:

E. Standards – Vegetation Retention. Minimum native vegetation retention standards shall apply to all projects located partially or fully within areas designated and mapped as open space corridors pursuant to ~~Section~~ PCC 19A.30.170 of the Pierce County Comprehensive Plan (Open Space) or an adopted community plan as follows, except that shoreline vegetation retention shall be regulated pursuant to Chapter 18S.30 PCC:
