



Spanaway Park Reservation Rules & Regulations

- PIERCE COUNTY CODE CHAPTER 14.08 WILL GOVERN PARK FACILITIES
- Picnic Shelters can be reserved from May through September, up to six months in advance.
- Complete a Spanaway Park Shelter application form to request use at Spanaway Park. The application is not finalized until payment in full is received and a permit is issued.
- When renting an area in Spanaway Park, the reservation fees do not include the boat launching fees nor the parking/entrance fee required to enter or the boat launching fees.
- Reservations are scheduled from 10:00 a.m. until dusk. Reserved shelters may not be cleaned prior to 10 a.m.
- Alcoholic beverages are NOT allowed in Pierce County Parks and Recreation facilities.
- Trash must be placed in the dumpsters provided in designated areas of the park. All participants are responsible for their own set-up and clean-up.
- It is recommended to see and become familiar with the picnic shelter's overall condition prior to submitting the reservation application. Due to the effects of rain, wind, and other park patrons, the outdoor facilities may not be as clean upon arrival as when routine maintenance was completed.
- Pets are to be kept on a leash no longer than 8 feet, or confined, and under control at all times.
- Confetti, hot air balloons, remote control airplanes or vehicles are NOT allowed in the park.
- Self-contained barbecues are allowed in the park and must be a minimum of six inches off the ground. Patrons are responsible to remove and dispose of the coals and/or grease outside of the park.
- Pierce County Parks and Recreation does not have lifeguards on duty at their parks.
- The swimming beaches at Spanaway Park may be unavailable during the rental dates due to posting by the Pierce County Health Department.
- A copy of the picnic shelter permit must be made available on the day of the reservation.
- Cancellation, or rescheduling, of the event will be charged a non-refundable \$25 fee. Picnic shelter cancellations must be made at least 14 days in advance of the reservation date to be eligible for a refund.
- There are no refunds for cancellations made within 14 days before the original scheduled reservation date.
- Pierce County Parks and Recreation has the right to cancel/refund a picnic shelter reservation.
