Registration fee is \$35 per booth per date. (NON-Refundable). You keep ALL your proceeds!!

Items must be hand made by the vendor. Items for sale must be appropriate as this is a family event. We reserve the right to ask you to remove items deemed inappropriate or offensive. No direct sales accepted for this event.

BOOTH SPACE

1. Booth space: 10' x 10'
2. Two booth spaces limit per customer per family
3. You will need to provide your own:
 - a. Table(s) Must be contained within the 10' x 10' booth space
 - b. Chairs
 - c. Tents with weights – Must be used on all 4 legs of tent
 - d. You will be responsible to complete your own set-up. Please bring your own supplies such as table cloth, backdrops, and change fund. – NO under tent heating allowed!
4. All items must be contained within booth space.
5. Each vendor must always monitor their own booth space.
6. No power available. If you choose to supply your own generator it must be marketed as a "Quite" generator.

SET-UP

1. Set-up begins at 1:30 pm
2. Vehicles are to park at or near booth spaces for unloading and then relocated to designated parking no later than 2:45 pm, DO NOT park in hash mark areas.
3. Limited carts will be available so please consider providing your own.
4. Set up must be completed by 2:45 pm

TAKE-DOWN

1. Take down begins at **7:00 pm and must be completed by 8:00 pm**, early breakdown is not permitted.
2. If you sell out of product you are still required to stay until 7:00 pm.
3. All garbage to be placed in containers.
4. All items must leave with you.

ITEMS FOR SALE - HOMEMADE FOOD is prohibited

Items must be hand made by the vendor and family appropriate. Commercially packaged and sealed food only. Must be local. It is the vendors' responsibility to ensure food permits are in order if need be. Please contact the Pierce County Health Department for questions regarding permits, 253-798-4709.
