

2019 – Reimagining Environmental Education

1. Inclusive Language and Queer Pedagogy: changing gender binary beliefs, language and attitudes.
2. Save Firgrove - 1935 School Building: Repurposing underused school space as a nature/ environment center.
3. From Control to Symbiosis: Reconnecting Ourselves with Nature , Right in our Own Backyards.
4. Invitation into Community Reparation Conversations : Can restorative justice be advanced through community conversations looking at perspectives on reparations?
5. Communication Collaboratives with Schools: Prototypes for collaborations between EE COI and students, staff and faculty (Sherman elementary in Tacoma).
6. Arts and The Environment Dancing Together: In what ways can we celebrate the natural and historic connections between nature's "landscape" and human "Artsapes" ? (Tacoma Symphony and Tacoma Ocean Fest)

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
